Calculation to capture the expenditure data lines used

- Source Data is submitted by District Chief Financial Officer or Business Manager
- Data is submitted through the Finance December Data Pipeline Collection
- A calculated Current Expenditure is from four data pulls (excluding Capital, Debt and Community Services)

MOE Calculation

- US DOE: Non-Regulatory Guidance
- LEA must maintain 90% spending in state and local funds based on Current Expenditure and Per Pupil.



Calculation to capture the expenditure data lines used

- A calculated Current Expenditure is from four data pulls
 - The First Data Pull excludes activities related to Capital, Debt and Community Services. This is excluded based on the Funds, Program Codes and Object Codes for the State and Local Grant Codes.
 - The Second Data Pull captures resources from the General Fund used to support the Food Service and Pupil/Student Activity.
 - The Third Data Pull captures Food Service Activity supported within the General Fund.
 - The Fourth Data Pull excludes resources received from Federal Funds through Indirect Costs.



MOE Calculation

- LEA must maintain 90% spending in state and local funds based on Current Expenditure and Per Pupil.
 - Current Expenditure is based on the Data Pulls from the previous slides.
 - Pupil Count is the Audited FTE Count Used provided through the School Finance Act worksheets. (V4, V5, V17, V19, V20 and V20.1)
 - The Required 90% Level is based on the Prior Year Data, an LEA must Pass at least one of the required 90% level of Current Expenditures and Expenditures per Pupil.
 - If LEA fails both measures:
 - Five year look back provision allowed under ESSA, if Districts did not fail MOE in the previous five years.
