## Afterschool Snack Program Review Form

School Food Authorities must review each Afterschool Snack Program (ASP) two times per school year per <u>7 CFR 210.9 (c) (7)</u>. The first review must be conducted during the first four weeks of program operation. The ASP review assesses each program's compliance with counting and claiming procedures and the snack meal pattern. This form can be used in completing these reviews. Documentation of the completed reviews must be kept on file for three years plus the current school year. If any items are marked "no," a Corrective Action (CA) box should be marked, and subsequent information should be provided, explaining corrective actions. All necessary actions should be taken immediately and should allow for all questions to have a "yes" marked after the corrective actions have been taken.
