RESOLUTION: CONCERNING ONLINE EDUCATION

WHEREAS. public online education is important to support the learning opportunities of students; and WHEREAS. the State Board of Education's role is the general supervision of education in the state, including schools providing online education programs; and WHEREAS, the State Board of Education's accreditation system ensures accountability for all public schools in the state, including online schools; and WHEREAS. the number of online schools is increasing in the state, and the prevalence of online programs is growing rapidly, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Colorado State Board of Education supports the following principles regarding online schools in the state: THAT they provide thorough and uniform educational opportunities for all of their students. THAT through the process of accrediting local school districts that provide online educational programs, the state determines whether such equitable opportunities are being provided to Colorado students. the online curricula of all online schools meet Colorado State THAT Model Content Standards for each of the content areas when taught in online schools. THAT school districts providing online programs ensure that their online programs comply with all federal requirements. school districts providing online programs ensure that their THAT online programs comply with all state requirements.
