DENVER METRO AREA STUDENT MEMBERSHIP

The Denver Metro Area includes 418,259 (55.2%) of the state's total Fall 2003 student membership (757,668) in public schools. From Fall 1993 to Fall 2003 student membership in the Denver Metro Area increased by 82,252 students (24.5%). The total increase for all other Colorado school districts during that period was 50,354 students (17.4%).
